

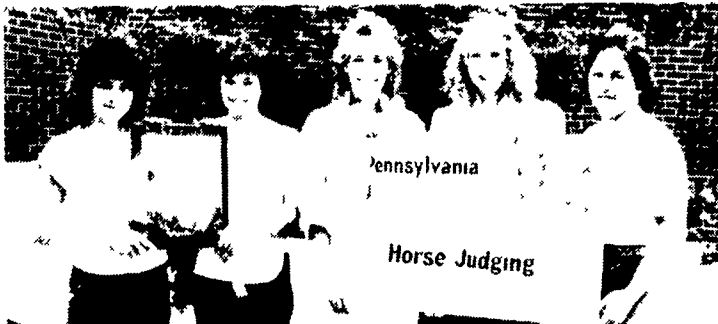

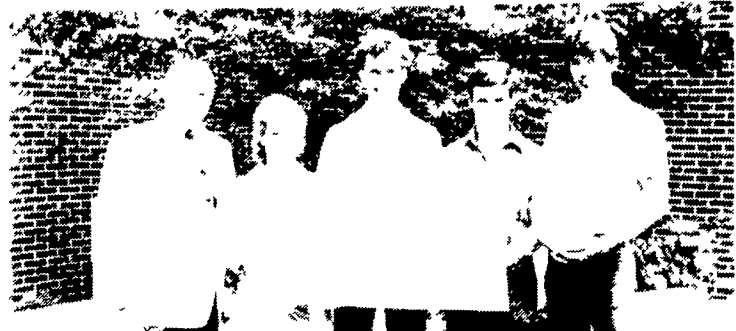

Red Rose Beef Club

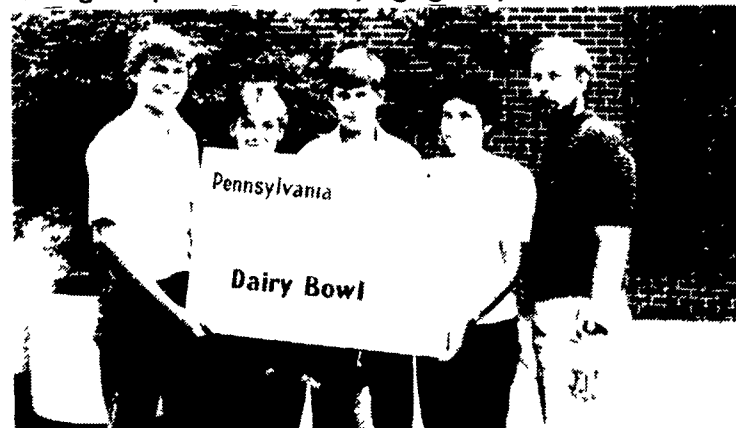
The annual Red Rose 4-H Beef Club tour was held on Wednesday, August 1 in the Manheim area.
