COLLEGE PARK, Md. - Forty Maryland dairy farms are being selected to participate in a twoyear demonstration project to show producers how then can increase annual income as much as \$200 per cow.

The dairy management pilot program is another part of a Profitable and Efficient Production (PEP) three-year educational endeavor of the Univsersity of Maryland's Cooperative Extension Service.

Phase II of the PEP program was begun early this year with a statewide educational campaign which concentrated on milk quality and mastitis control in dairy cows. That effort used closed-circuit television and conference telephone hook-ups to reach 650 persons from 350 dairy farms gathered at 22 locations in a series of one-day meetings.


