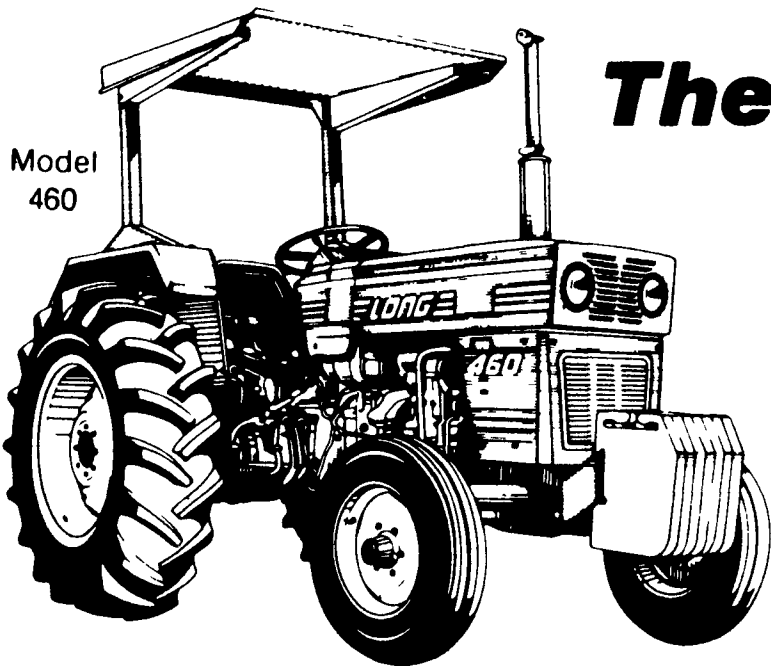
According to Kutil, part of the motivation for the name change is the rapid growth of propane gas sales. "Agway Energy Products,"

Currently, Agway Energy Products sells a broad range of liquid energy fuels, including home heating oils, propane gas, motor fuels, diesel fuels, and lubricants.



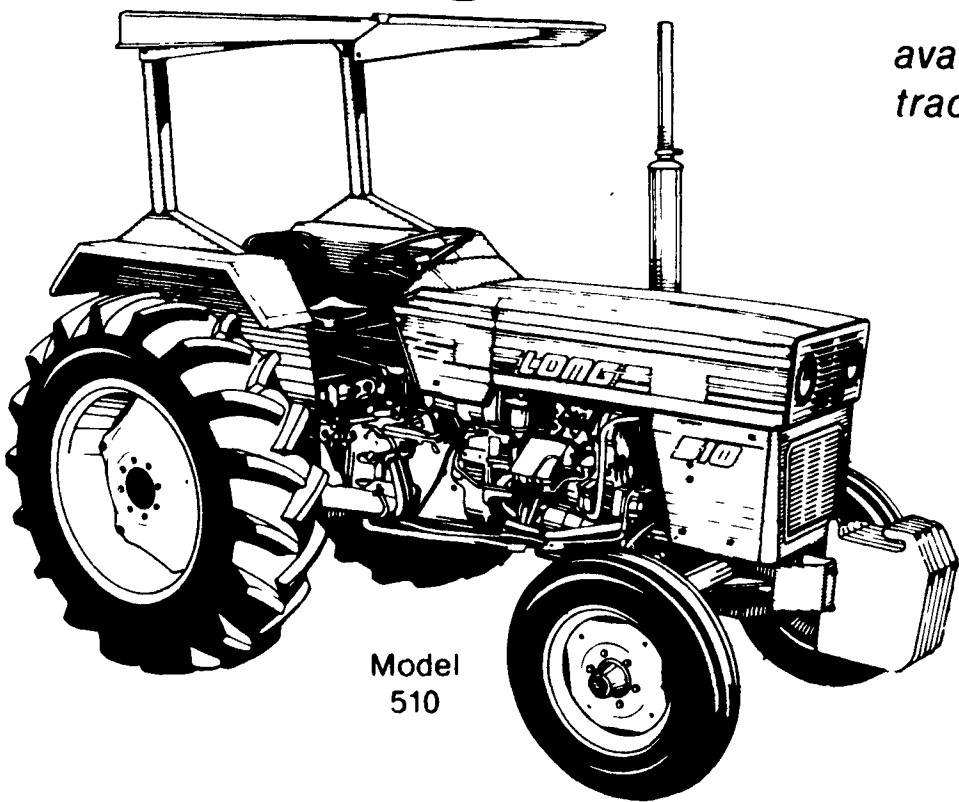
