ady to build a barn or shed but don't have the confidence to attempt your own design, the newly revised "Pole and Post Buildings revised "Pole and Post Buildings Handbook" is just what you need,
says University of Delaware exsays University of Delaware ex-
tension agricultural engineer tension agricultural
James Scarborough.
In pole or post construction, round or rectangular posts embedded in the ground become the foundation and support for your structure. It's generally the easiest, fastest, and least expensive construction method, Scarborough says. Even the Scarborough says. Even the
building site requires little building site requires ittle prepara
starts.
starts.
Often used for storage or animal housing, this versatile construction method can also be used for wood decks, boat shelters, cabins, warehouses, and even aircraft hangars.
The "Pole and Post Buildings Handbook," published by the Northeast Regional Agricultural Engineering Service, has sections on site selection, framing and roofing materials, wood treatments, roof trusses, doors, skylights, and other basic information necessary to a designer.
The section on building design is presented in a straightforward manner, Scarborough says, with heavy emphasis on using tables to heavy emphasis on using tables to
find the sizes of poles, girts, purlins find the sizes of poles, girts, purlins and other framing members. The publication also explains how to
allow for snow and wind load, and how to compensate for sloping sites.
Once you've completed your design, you are ready for the construction phase. The handbook is equally straightforward in explaining this element of the process. Scarborough says the
step-by-step instructions are simple enough for a novice to attempt without fear.
Also included in the handbook are several U.S. Department of Agriculture plans reduced to booklet size, including designs for a two-stall horse barn, a large, general purpose pole barn, a twocar garage, and others.
Farmers, builders and do-ityourselfers should find the handbook a valuable reference, Scarborough says. It is available for $\$ 3.50$.
