The July 1984 report of the Juniata County Dairy Herd Improvement Association is as follows. Records were calculated for 4 135 cows in 81 herds.

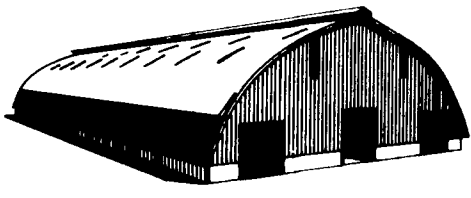
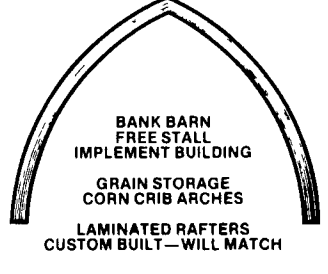
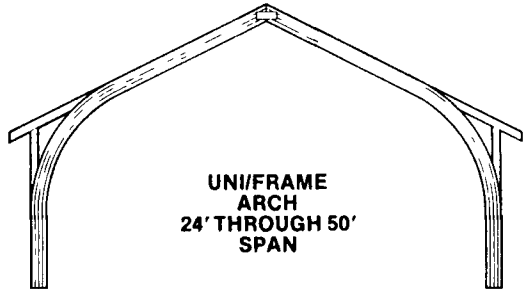
