

Low-grade corn still available

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Secretary of Agriculture John R. Block has announced that livestock producers in counties previously designated by the U.S. Department of Agriculture as disaster areas due to drought or excess moisture will continue to be eligible to buy Commodity Credit Corporation-owned lower grade corn under the emergency feed assistance program.

CCC is continuing the program because producers have not harvested their 1984 crop in most states and there is still widespread drought. Also, some producers who were eligible for feed due to excess moisture were not able to plant their crops and will have no fall harvest.

Approximately 6 million bushels of U.S. No. 4, U.S. No. 5 and sample grade corn remain to be sold to eligible livestock

producers. The bulk of this corn is located in Texas, Nebraska, Minnesota, North Dakota and South Dakota.

The cost to eligible producers will still be 75 percent of the current basic county loan rate for the average quality of available corn in the county where the corn is stored. Producers are responsible for transportation costs to move the corn to their farms.

Producers also need to show their feed production is inadequate to maintain foundation livestock and poultry during the remainder of the current 90 day feeding period, which begins the day a farmer applies for assistance.

Producers should continue to contact offices of USDA's Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Service for program details and application for assistance.


