The Brown Swiss show featured over 80 entries with the three year old entry of Gayle Army, Coopersburg, Lehigh County, besting them all for the grand championship. Buzzing Acres Rochelle, daughter of West Lawn Stretch Improver, was bred by Daryl Army, Gayle's brother. "They helped me a lot," Gayle said about her three older brothers. This was the first time 15-year-old Gayle was this successful at the state level and she looks forward to the national show.

Reserve grand champion honors went to the veteran winner, Kathleen Kopistecki, Royersford, with DN Delegate Dainty, her aged cow. "The judge liked her depth and strength of ribs," Kopistecki stated. The Montgomery County Dairy Princess was pleased with her win and was in the process of trying to find a friend to show her cow in the Eastern National Show while she competed in the dairy princess pageant.

Mike Welsh, York County, garnered the junior championship with Welsh Ponderosa Kings Bobbi

Jo. Winning with his Brown Swiss last year in Kentucky, Welsh looks forward to competing there again this year.

The intermediate calf of Janelle Kennedy, Butler County, took the reserve junior champion ribbons.

The Milking Shorthorn show featured the three-year-old entry of Greg Gessner, Crawford County. The daughter of Mar-Vi-Nic Fury, Mar-Vi-Nic Cherry Blossom, not only took the grand championship ribbons but the best bred and owned rosette too. The 15-year-old son of Martin and Judy Gessner, Springboro, stated that this was one of his best days. His

cow was also awarded the best udder ribbons.

The reserve grand champion went to the four-year-old entry of Maggie Whitting, Lawrence County. Junior championship was taken by Christine Young, Cumberland County, who also received the reserve honors with her senior calf.

Almost 150 entries in the Jersey show were bested by the aged cow entry of Denise Martin, Franklin County, as she took the grand championship. Top-O-Hill Milestone Faithful also took the best udder honors in her class.

Reserve grand champion went to Michele Sparling, Tioga County. The 12-year-old junior bought her winner as a calf and raised it on her parents' Holstein farm.

The junior champion was the senior calf of James Hardy, Huntingdon County. Tee Pee Justin Bella was purchased at the Ohio Springtime Show and Sale. Hardy stated that his uncle selected the heifer for him and she had done well all year.

Elizabeth Jenkins, Chester County, won the reserve honors with a graduation present from her

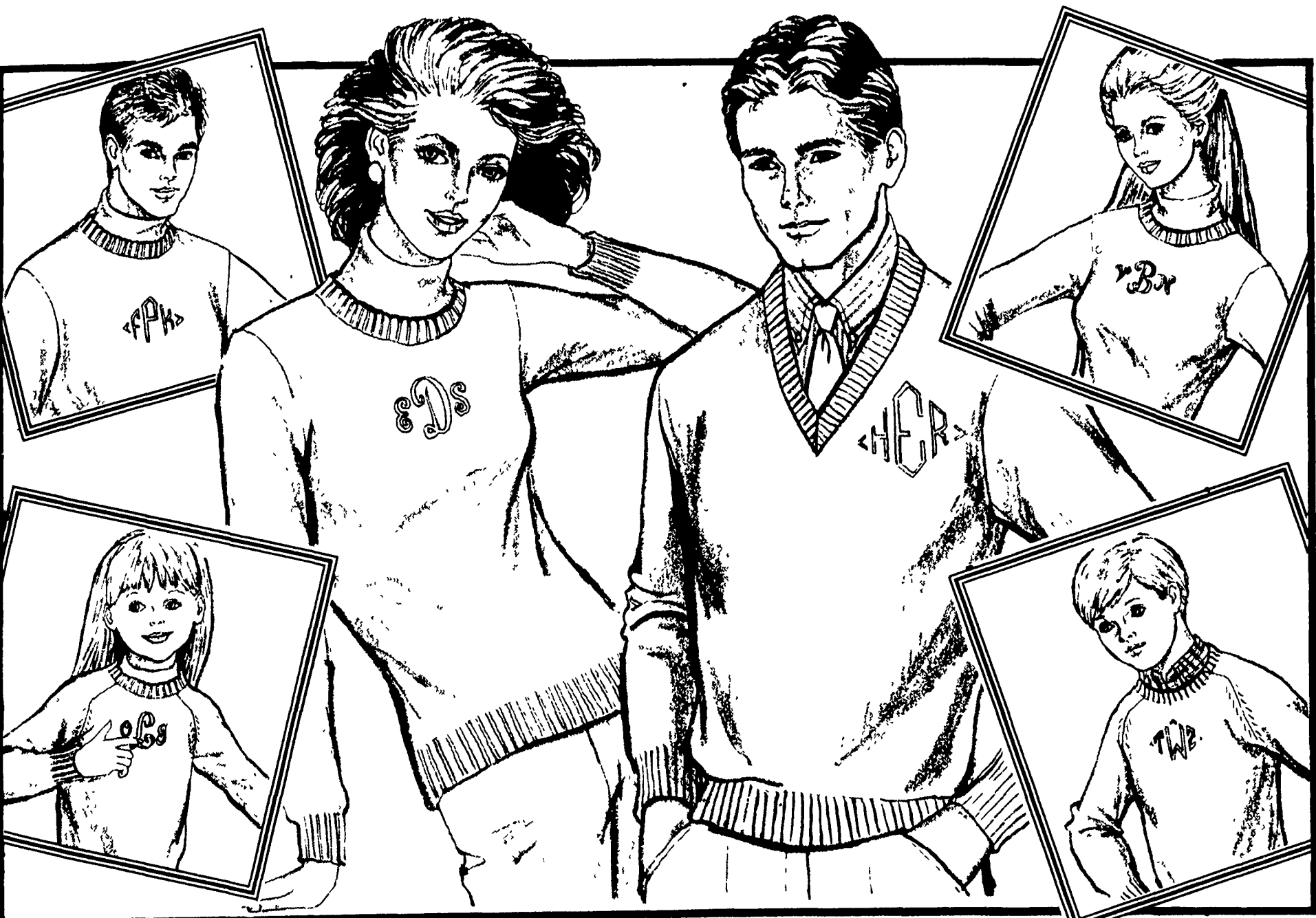
