No "dark horse" entry, Cooper's female, nicknamed Sweetie Pie, placed second in her class at the National Junior Show, and was champion bred-and-owned heifer in the Ohio Preview Show.

The show's top Chianina female was exhibited by Jamie Kohr of York, Pa. Bred by Lauxmont Farms, the Feb. '83, heifer was sired by Ino, out of Lezina, both fullblood Chianinas.

Laura Tessier of Laytonville, Md., brought honor to the home state by exhibiting the champion Hereford female. A March, '83 heifer, PRL757 Cherry was sired by BTPRL Driver, and was a class winner at the Junior National Show in Iowa. Miss Tessier also showed the reserve champion Hereford, an

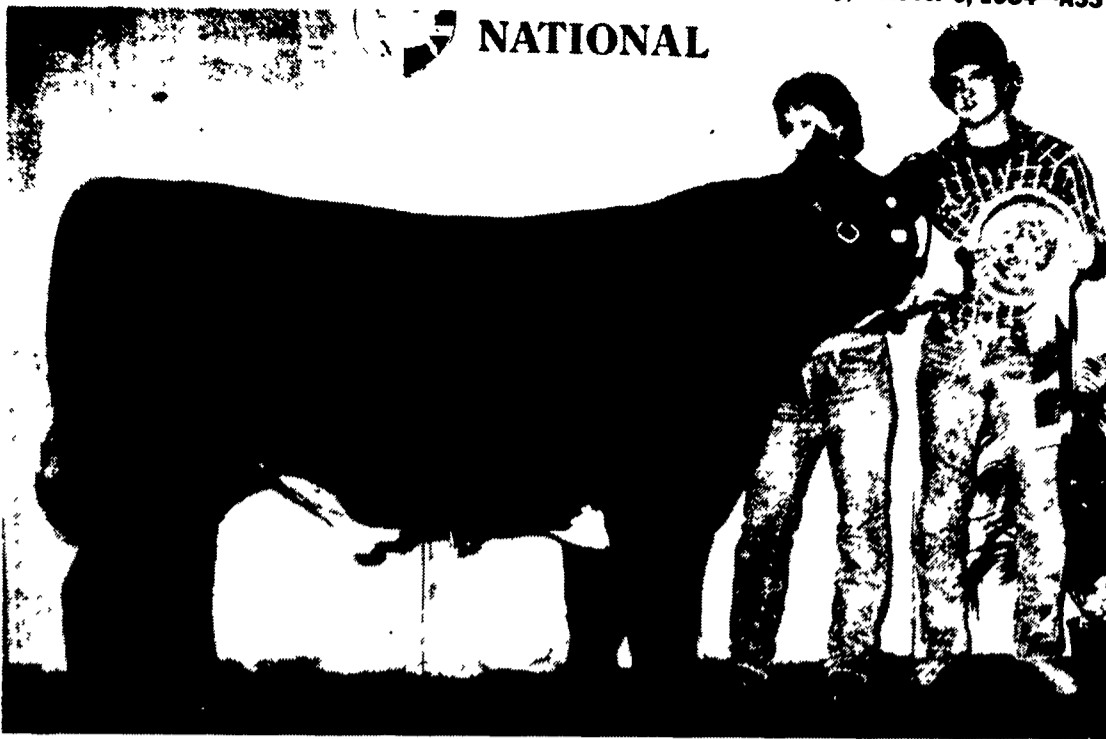
April, '83, Hotline daughter.

Top Charolais honors went to Pennsylvania's Crystal Clutter, of Prosperity. Her heifer, named Riverwood Streamline, was a March, '83, entry.

Both champion and reserve champion Limousin honors went to Bruce Bassler, of Ellicott City, Md.

For John Callebs, the long drive from Lexington, Kent., was time well spent. In addition to showing the reserve champion Simmental steer earlier in the day, Callebs' Simmental heifers took both champion and reserve honors. His champion heifer, named JC Miss Savior 100R, is a Savior daughter, and his reserve champion was sired by a son of Extra.

In Shorthorn competition, judge Lanthicum once again came home to Maryland, naming a Steck's Generator daughter shown by Richard Hodiak of Woodbine, as his champion female.

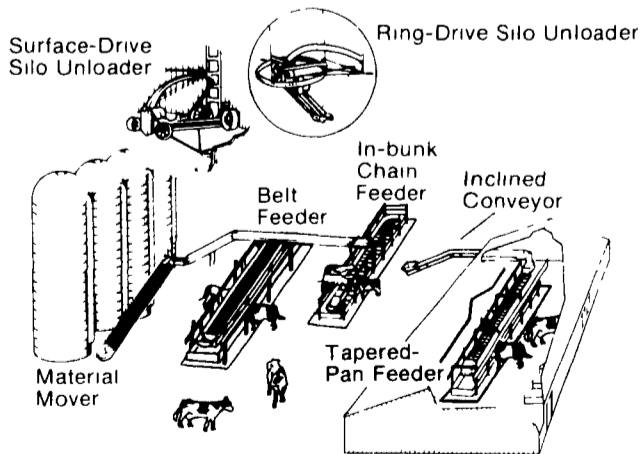

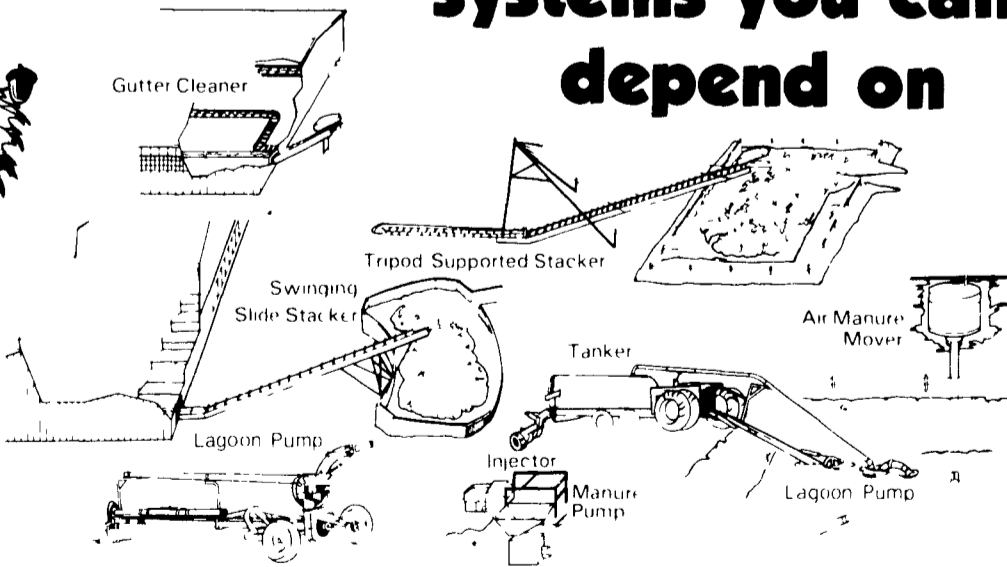
