

Royal Charolais posts sale results

GREENSBURG — Buyers representing 23 states and two Canadian provinces converged on Greensburg on Sept. 29, for the Royal Charolais Company's 10th annual sale. Bidding was spirited as auctioneer Stanley Stout offered a total of 50½ lots to the largest crowd ever to attend a Royal Charolais sale.

As a special 10th anniversary

event, Royal selected four of its top cows, offering the choice of any one of the cows to the highest bidder. With a bid of \$21,000, the winning buyer selected the 1981 Denver junior national champion.

The sales 50½ lots averaged \$2,824, for a sale total of \$141,900. Managing the sale was Buzz Garey of Garey Cattle Sales, Morrisville.

NAILE to host World Shorthorn Conference

LOUISVILLE, Ky. — Shorthorn producers from around the world will gather at this fall's North American International Livestock Exposition for the Fourth World Shorthorn Conference and World Shorthorn Shows. November 8-11, will see visitors from nine countries travel to Louisville, Ky., to take part in meetings and seminars designed to acquaint the cattlemen with updated technological advances in the beef cattle industry and the world wide production of Shorthorns and their polled counterparts.

The first World Shorthorn Conference was held in 1974 in South Africa. From there, the conference was moved to Sydney, Australia in 1977, and Calgary, Alberta, Canada in 1980. The conference is held every three years, and is sponsored by the World Shorthorn Council and the hosting country. This will be the second time that the conference has been held on the North American continent, but the first time that the world wide symposium has even been held on

American soil. Countries that will be represented include: Australia, Canada, Great Britain, Ireland, New Zealand, United States, Argentina, Zimbabwe, and South Africa.

Activities will be held at the Kentucky Fair & Exposition Center, and throughout the city of

Louisville and the surrounding areas. Visitors will enjoy the competition of the World Shorthorn Bull and Female Show, the junior Shorthorn show, and the Second Annual North American Heifer Calf Futurity. Spectators will also witness the first Shorthorn steer futurity show.

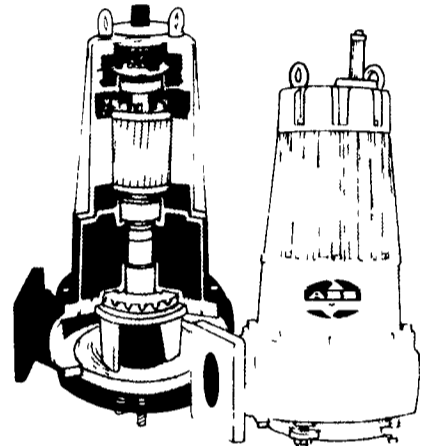

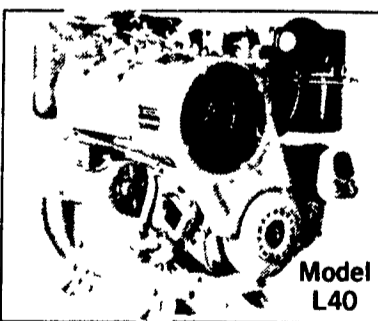

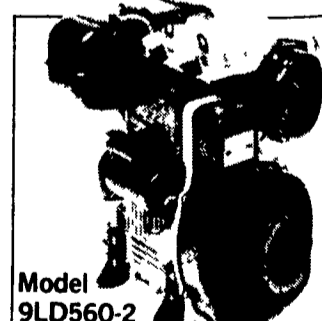
