

Bucks Co. 4-H'ers to attend National Horse Bowl

DOYLESTOWN — Three Bucks County 4-H members will be representing Pennsylvania at the U.S. Invitational 4-H Horse Round-up on Saturday, Nov. 3, at the Pennsylvania Farm Show Building in Harrisburg.

The members will be competing in the 4-H Horse Bowl event, an

event which is similar to the "College Bowl" game, where members answer questions in toss-up and bonus rounds. The questions in the 4-H Horse Bowl Competition are based on horse management and veterinary science information.

Matthew McLaughlin, 15,

Quakertown, will be the team captain. Matthew has been a member of the Spurs 'N Burrs 4-H Club for four years, and is a teen leader of his 4-H Club.

Jennifer Kline, 15, Hellertown, has also belonged to the Spurs 'N Burrs 4-H Club for four years. Her 4-H project is Horse and Clover.

Kathy Moss, 15, Perkasio, is in her first year as a 4-H Horse Club member. Kathy is also a member of the Danboro 4-H Club.

The team has practiced throughout the summer and placed third at Pennsylvania State 4-H Achievement Days in August.

Mrs. Nancy Hottle, Cooperstown, is the volunteer 4-H leader who has coached the Bucks County 4-H Horse Bowl teams for the past

eight years. Four of the teams have gone on to the National 4-H Roundups.

The Pennsylvania Livestock Association has donated a \$200 scholarship to finance the team's expenses in Harrisburg.
