

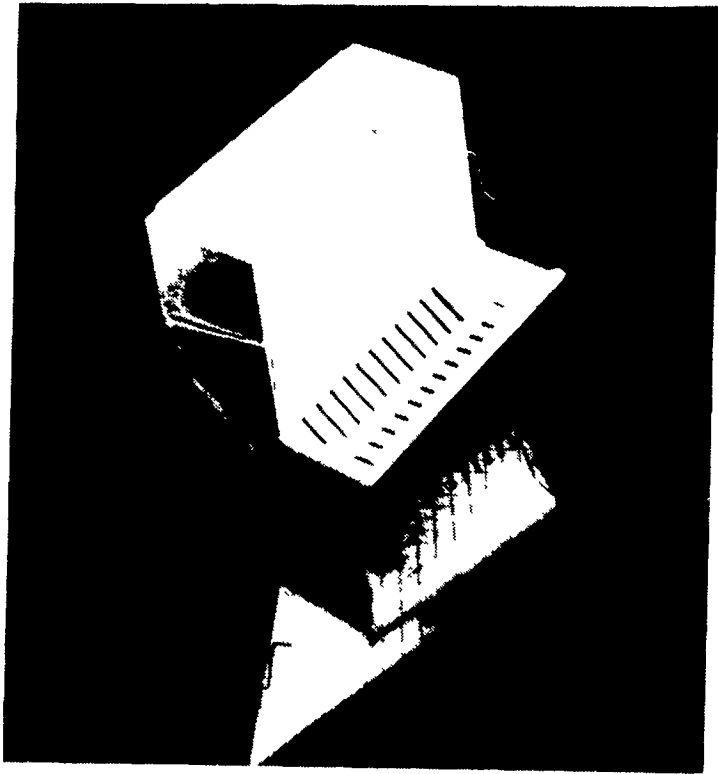
New rabbit feeder improves feed efficiency

Lehigh Valley pays cash dividend

LANSDALE — Lehigh Valley Farmers paid its producer members a cash distribution of \$275,000 recently as part of its annual patronage dividend.

At the same time the Lansdale-based cooperative announced that its members had shipped a record high 453 million pounds of milk during the six months of the year, an increase of 10 percent over the same period last year.

President Alpheus L. Ruth said, "Our members look forward to these extra payments, which are good indicators of our growth and success of our marketing programs."

The \$275,000 cash distribution was part of an overall patronage dividend of \$1,375,000. The balance of \$1,100,000 was issued in equity certificates.

On a per hundredweight basis the total dividend represented 16 cents for all milk shipped last year, with the cash portion amounting to three and a half cents. For the average shipper the cash was approximately \$225.

Funds for the cash distribution and the equity allocation were generated from operating profits of the Lehigh Valley Farmers cooperative and the Atlantic Processing federation to which Lehigh belongs.

(Lehigh Valley Farmers has a

long-term contract with Atlantic Processing, Inc. of Allentown, Pa., for the purchase of all milk produced by Lehigh members.)

Lehigh's financial growth continues to attract new dairy farmers to the organization whose membership now totals 1,316. Lehigh's shipments to API have increased 100 million pounds a year in each of the last three years.

Ruth plans to cover these developments in a series of district meetings to be held throughout the cooperatives milkshed during November.
