Ag Eng. course okayed


NEWARK, DEL. — After a rigorous, year-long review process, the University of Delaware's agricultural engineering technology program has been accredited by the Technology Accreditation Commission of the Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology.

The four-year university program stresses the application

of scientific and engineering knowledge to the practical, engineering-related problems graduates will encounter in agribusiness and related industries. Students are trained to evaluate production and processing systems and modify them to achieve optimum performance. The academic program involves extensive use of the computer in analyzing production systems.

According to Norman E. Collins, head of the department of agricultural engineering, the newly accredited program evolved from the university's agricultural mechanization program of 30 years ago. In addition to improving departmental course offerings, calculus, physics, management and communications courses have been added to make the program academically rigorous.

Graduates are employed as plant operators, feed mill supervisors, quality control specialists in the poultry industry, and construction supervisors.
