CLINTON COUNTY DHIA July, 1984

LOCK HAVEN — The top herd in the Clinton County DHIA for July is owned by Paul L. Courter, RD#2, Mill Hall, and the cow completing the highest lactation was also owned by Paul L. Courter.

The top herd of Registered Holsteins completed the month with a Rolling Herd Average of 18,566 pounds of milk per cow yielding 707 pounds of butterfat.

Other top herds were — Tom & Grace Nicholas, RD#2 Loganton, 17 656 pounds of milk, 688 pounds of butterfat.

— Anthony and Caroline Graine, RD#1, Mill Hall, 19,328 pounds of milk, 686 pounds of butterfat.

— Terry & Deb Dickey, RD#1 Mill Hall 17,870 pounds of milk, 663 pounds of butterfat.

The cow completing the highest lactation of 305 days or less was Blacky, a 7½-year-old Holstein owned by Paul L. Courter, RD#2, Mill Hall. Blacky produced 24,103 pounds of milk testing at 3 7 percent, yielding 894 pounds of butterfat in 305 days.

Other top producing cows were — Tutti, owned by Anthony & Caroline Graine, RD#1, Mill Hall 22,447 pounds of milk, 3 6 percent, 815 pounds of butterfat.

— Teresa, owned by Richard L. Schenck, RD#2, Mill Hall, 21,825 pounds of milk, 3 7 percent, 807 pounds of butterfat.

— Diane 2, owned by Paul L. Courter, RD#2, Mill Hall, 20,517 pounds of milk, 3 9 percent, 800 pounds of butterfat.

— Esta, owned by Robert Billman, RD#1, Beech Creek 17,565 pounds of milk, 4 5 percent, 792 pounds of butterfat.

— 92, owned by Paul Dotterer, RD#2, Mill Hall, 17,956 pounds of milk, 4 3 percent, 768 pounds of butterfat.

— Tracy, owned by Ward & Keith Carson, RD#1, Jersey Shore, 17,504 pounds of milk, 4 3 percent, 757 pounds of butterfat.

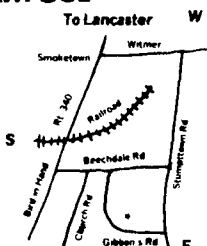

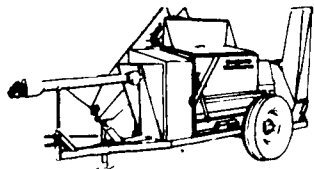

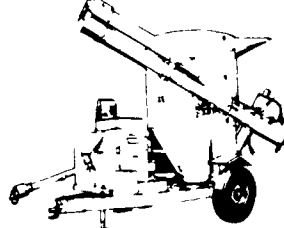
