National Grange to meet

WASHINGTON, D.C. - The 1985 farm bill, tax policies affecting agriculture, conservation programs, trade issues and social security will be among the issues on the legislative agenda next month at the annual convention of the National Grange.

Meeting in Portland, Me., Nov. 12-18, delegates from 36 states, representing 400,000 Grange members, will debate over 500 resolutions. Action taken by the delegates will determine Grange legislative policies and programs for the coming year. Edward Andersen, Master of the National Grange, said the Grange's position on provisions in the 1985 farm bill will be determined at this convention. "There will also be considerable attention given to the federal budget deficit and high interest rates," said Andersen.

The Grange will be the first major farm organization to meet following the Presidential election. Thousands are expected to attend as one-fourth of the Grange's total membership is located throughout the New England states. The Grange is also a fraternal order and confers the highest degree of the order at their annual conventions.

National awards will also be announced including Youth Ambassadors of the Year and Young Couple of the Year.
