World Food Day held

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Secretary of Agriculture John R. Block keynoted the official United States participation in World Food Day on Oct. 16, an annual international event involving more than 150 nations.

World Food Day is sponsored by the Food and Agricultural Organization (FAO) of the United Nations to focus public attention on world food issues.

The U.S. program took place at the Department of Agriculture's Administration building.

Secretary Block and Peter McPherson, Administrator of the Agency for International Development (AID) were the major speakers, addressing the U.S. theme, "Helping Others to Help Themselves."

USDA also sponsored a symposium, "Women: The Secret Weapon in the War on World Hunger." Coordinated by USDA's Office of International Cooperation and Development (OICD), the symposium focused on the role of rural women in developing countries.

In 1979, member nations of the FAO, unanimously established World Food Day as an annual observance and decreed the first event be held in 1981. It is estimated that more than 300 million people worldwide observed World Food Day last year.

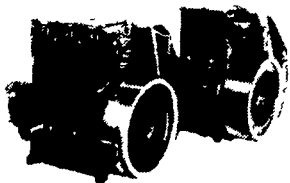

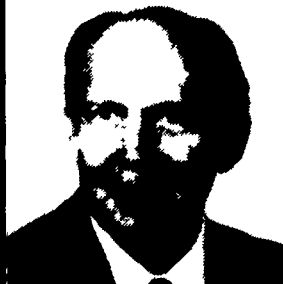
