Each participating puller received a kite from Lancaster Ford Tractor

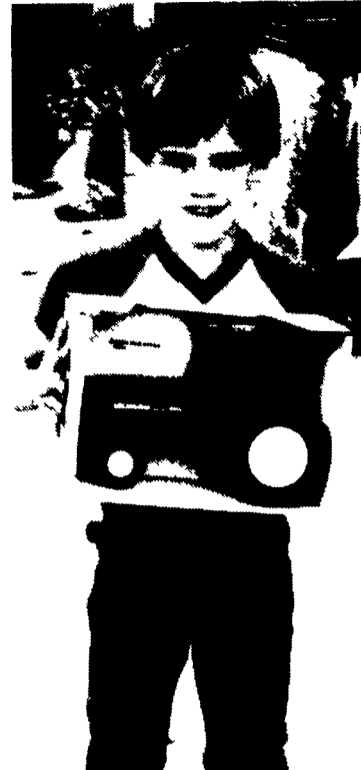

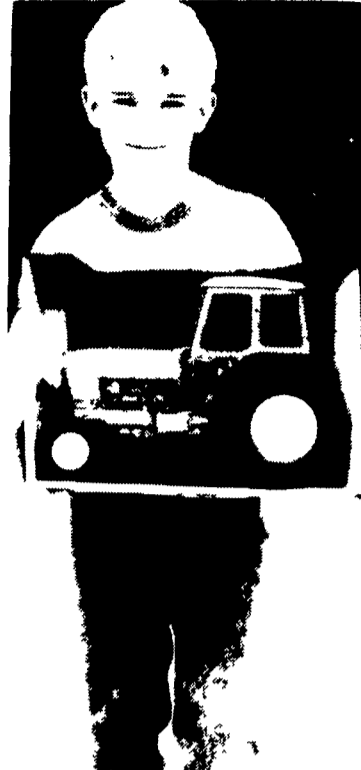
Tied among 9-10 year-olds are Willis, left, and Shane Weiler.
