Because Ronald Reagan Keeps His Promises

- In 1980, Candidate Reagan promised to curb inflation. He did. Inflation has dropped from 12 percent to 4 percent. Every percentage point decline in inflation has saved \$1.5 billion in farm production expenses.
- In 1980, Candidate Reagan promised to revitalize the economy. He did. Interest rates have dropped from 21.5 percent to 12.5 percent. Every percentage point decline translates into a \$2 to \$3 billion savings in net farm income.

He has since engineered a five-year trade pact with the Soviet Union. But above all, the United States has regained its reputation as a reliable supplier in the global marketplace.

BMP's: Stripcropping, Waterways, Cropland Protective System and Conservation Tillage System.
