October, 1984

Cumberland County Dairy Herd Improvement records show that 4,719 cows in 82 herds were on production testing in October, according to Duane G. Duncan, County Agent. Of the 65 herds on DHIA, 32 herds had an average fat production of 600 pounds. During the month 77 completed their 305 lactation with 650 lbs. of butterfat. The following are the highest of actual butterfat in 305 days or less in the county during the month. The age listed is her age at the time of freshening.
