Farmland preservation

Farmland preservation in Eastern Lancaster County will be the subject of a public meeting to be held on Wednesday, Jan. 23 at 7:30 p.m. at the Goodville Fire Hall, Rt. 23 in Goodville.

The meeting, sponsored by the East Earl Township Planning Commission, will give attendees an opportunity to receive information about Lancaster County's agricultural land preservation program. Discussion will focus on areas in East Earl Township and adjoining municipalities eligible to be in-

cluded in an Agricultural Preserve. Designation of an Agricultural Preserve establishes priority for implementation of the voluntary Deed Restriction Program to preserve County farmland.
