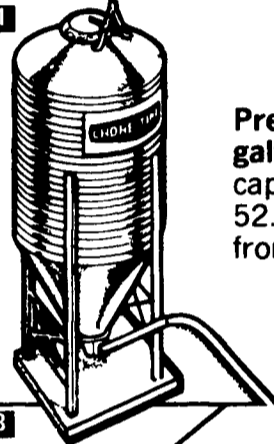
Corn growers
