Cows closed 2.00 to 3.00 higher with most advance on Canner and Cutter. Bulls not well tested, few sales .50 to 2.00 higher. Supply mainly good to low Choice Slaughter Steers and Heifers with 24% cows. Receipts this week about 750 as compared with 1498 a week ago and 2081 a year ago.

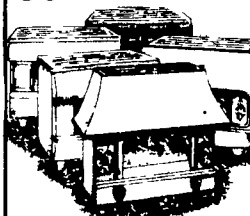
