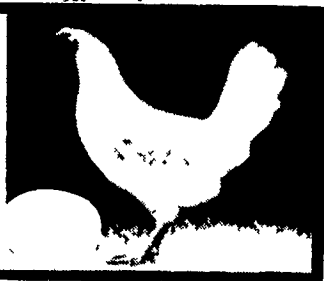

Market Comment: Prices were unchanged. Local sentiment mixed but mostly steady. Cartoned movement was irregular; improved in some quarters, light and disappointing in others. Several traders noted some degree of featuring but most reported volumes ordered as just enough to keep supplies moving. Floor stocks were in better balance at some points, heavy or building at others. Ungraded offerings yielding extra large and large sizes were ample. Class 3's and particularly 4's were under fairly active call.

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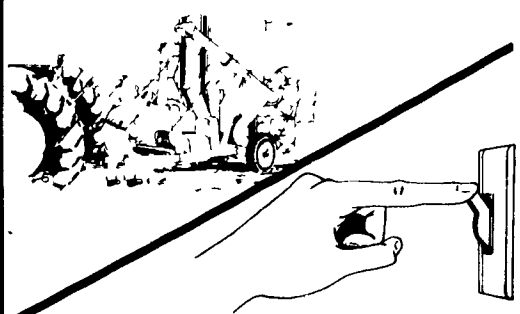
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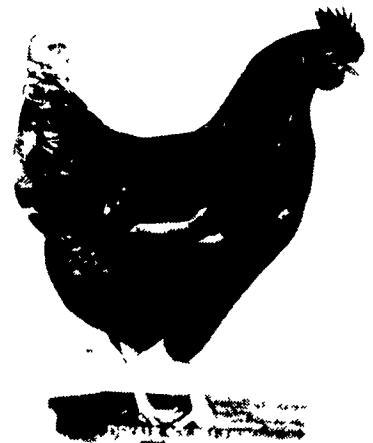


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
