

Top bulls to auction block on March 29

HARRISBURG — Approximately 65 of the Commonwealth's finest performance tested bulls cross the auction block at the 12th annual Performance Tested Bull Sale at noon Friday, March 29 in the Ag Arena of The Pennsylvania State University, University Park.

According to state Agriculture

Secretary Penrose Hallowell, these bulls will be screened from a group of 86 excellent bulls which recently completed tests at the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture's Meat Animal Evaluation Center, located adjacent to the Ag Arena.

"After 112 days on test, the average daily weight gain of the

animals was 3.6 pounds, meaning that the top 75 percent rated animals scheduled for sale should bring handsome prices," said Hallowell.

The sale offers purebred and commercial cattle breeders an excellent opportunity to obtain genetically superior bulls that have been evaluated for rate of gain on test; lifetime weight per day of age; feed efficiency; frame score; and structural and breeding soundness. The 86 bulls on test include 28 Polled Herefords, 28 Simmentals, 22 Angus, five Charolais, two Chianinas and one Shorthorn.
