The dairymen received their awards at the firm's annual Dairy Awards Banquet Wednesday at the Good 'n Plenty restaurant.

To achieve membership in the club, dairymen had to reach either the milk production or butter fat standard the company established for their particular breed.

The standards were 20,000 pounds of milk or 700 pounds of butterfat for Holsteins, 17,500 pounds of milk or 650 pounds of fat for Brown Swiss or Ayrshire, 13,500 pounds of milk or 650 pounds of fat for Guernseys, and 13,000 pounds of milk or 625 pounds of fat for




