NEW YORK - Dairy farmers who supplied milk plants regulated under the New York-New Jersey marketing orders during February 1985 will be paid on the basis of a uniform price of \$13.13 per hundredweight (28.2 cents per quart). Market Administrator Thomas A. Wilson also stated that the price was \$13.34 in January 1985 and \$12.79 in February 1984. The uniform price is a marketwide weighted average of the value of farm milk used for fluid and manufactured dairy products.

The seasonal incentive plan does not affect the uniform price for the month of February.

A total of 16,624 dairy farmers supplied the New York-New Jersey Milk Marketing Area with 870,914,618 pounds of milk during February 1985. This was a decrease of 6.1 percent (about 57

million pounds) from last year. or 58.2 percent) was used to The gross value to dairy farmers manufacture Class II products for milk deliveries was \$117,758,368.15. This included differentials required to be paid to dairy farmers but not voluntary premiums or deductions authorized by the farmer.

Regulated milk dealers (handlers) used 363,933,865 pounds of milk for Class I, 41.8 percent of the total. This milk is used for fluid milk products such as homogenized, flavored, low test, and skim milks. The call provision which was in effect for the month required handlers to meet a minimum Class I-A utilization of seven percent. For February 1985, handlers paid \$14.77 per hundredweight (31.8 cents per quart) for Class I milk compared with \$14.36 a year ago.

including butter, cheese, ice cream, and yogurt. Handlers paid \$12.23 per hundredweight for this milk.

The uniform price is based on milk containing 3.5 percent butterfat. For February 1985, there

was a price differential of 16.2 cents for each one-tenth of one percent that the milk tested above or below the 3.5 percent standard.

All prices quoted are for bulk tank milk received within the 201-210 milk zone from New York City.
