Extension Service have organized the meeting.

Mr. and Mrs. Larry Fredericks of Strawberry Valley Farm near Whitney Point, N.Y. will share their experiences in changing from

commercial dairy farm to a fruit and vegetable and a direct marketing program.

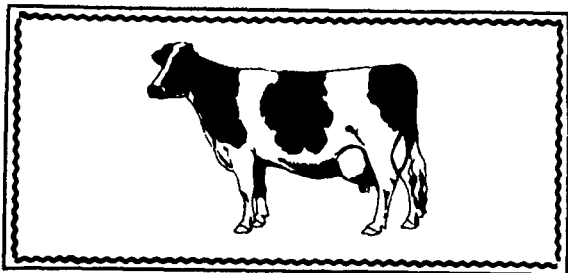
Jackie Greenfield, member of the State College Farmers Market, will explain the problems and opportunities in growing and marketing ethnic and specialty crops.

Extension area marketing agent, will demonstrate methods for displaying produce in retail markets.

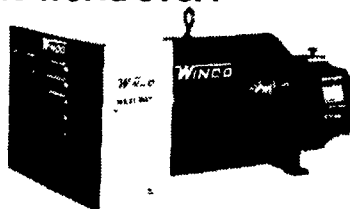
