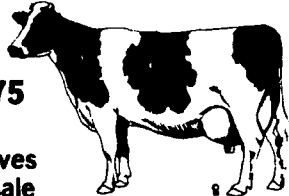
Mr. Warner has accepted a position at the Williamson School and has decided to disperse his complete herd. He has not fed for high production as he has participated in the milk diversion program.
