Hayes says farm families key to strength

ATGLEN, Pa. - Der Mann mit der Hock (the man with the hoe) was the central theme of the remarks made to a gathering of Chester County farmers here Friday night by State Representative and Republican Whip Samuel E. Hayes, Jr.

Representative Hayes, humself a farmer by profession, addressed the sociological, economic, and political expression of the farmer in America. He singled out the Chester County farmer as representing the bedrock of what works in America today.

"Pennsylvania has the largest rural population in all the land," said Hayes, "and we're all better off because of it. The Chester County farmer has helped make agriculture the number one

economic activity in the state nothing else even comes close.

Speaking at the West Fallowfield Christian Day School before an invited group of more than 225 farmers and their wives, Rep. Hayes commended the closeknit nature of the farming family and stressed how important this is to America's continued strength.


Of immediate concern to the farming community, Rep. Hayes expressed hopes that legislation on farmland preservation now before the assembly would become law in the current session.

He also stressed the importance of protecting farmland against international investors who could

easily dominate land ownership with the immense sums they have available for investment. He says the legislature is looking into ways to insure that Pennsylvania farmland remains in the hands of Pennsylvania farm families.

Friday night's Farm Appreciation Day Dinner, hosted by Fidelity Bank, was the fifth such annual affair. Marlene F. Rice, manager of Fidelity's Atglen branch, was official hostess for the evening.
