

Montgomery youth plan auction to benefit 4-H Center

CREAMERY Farm machinery, horse trailers, and horses will be among the numerous articles offered for sale at a special auction to be held on Saturday, April 13 at the Montgomery County 4-H Center in Creamery. The auction is being sponsored

by the Central 4-H Horse Club as a fund-raiser for the new 4-H Center. The articles being auctioned are either donations or are being sold

on a commission basis with proceeds to benefit 4-H.

Two horse trailers, a Kingston Four-Horse Tag-a-long trailer (thoroughbred size) and a reconditioned Four-Horse Miley trailer will start the auction at 11:30 a.m. Several horses, including a 12-year-old Appaloosa mare and a registered Quarter Horse, will be exhibited and offered for sale to potential buyers. Used tack and riding clothing will also be sold during the day.

Starting at 12:30 p.m. farm machinery items will be auctioned. Included among these items are a New Holland Sidewinder manure spreader, a wire tie bailer, Farm-all and John Deere tractors, an Allis Chalmers 720 field chopper and two combines. Several loads of hay and straw will also be sold.

Unique items such as two 270-gallon diesel fuel tanks, chicken feeders and a junior grain drill have also been promised. Many additional items will also be offered.

events being held that day at the 4-H Center. A flea market will start at 9 a.m. and is open to the public. Table space is still available at \$10. To reserve a spot call Mrs. Dot Jones at 495-6102.

A special 4-H Showcase will be the highlight of the day featuring various exhibits and club displays in order to acquaint the community with what 4-H has to offer to youth ages 8-19. Families are encouraged to attend and learn about 4-H opportunities.

Refreshments will be available including sandwiches, beverages and a ham dinner, all served by volunteer leaders and members.

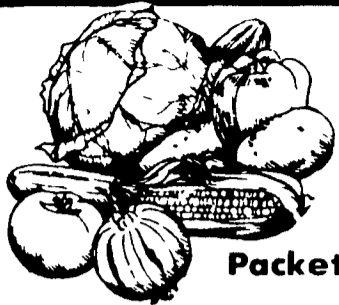
4-H Capon Club

Capons must be ordered soon. The charge for a four-week-old caponized chicken is \$1.75.

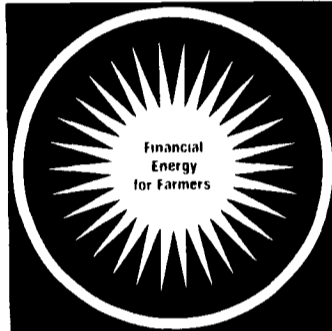

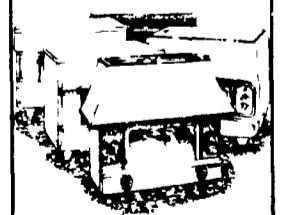

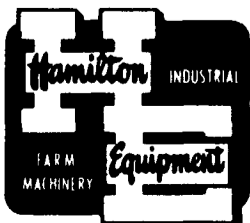
