Slaughter steers and heifers closed this week steady to 50 lower, heifers generally at full decline. Early week declines were mostly offset by midweek as a good demand developed, especially from buyers for cattle suitable for commodity futures delivery. Dressed beef prices generally on the downside compared to last week but packer buyers had to compete with commodity delivery buyers. Slaughter cows and bulls steady.

Estimated five day receipts this week 9,700 compared to actuals last week of 7,035 and 11,714 last year. Steers comprised 36 pct of the week's receipts, heifers 28 pct, cows 5 pct, feeders 29 pct.
