## Round baler has plastic wrap option

The M & W Round Baler is of the fixed cavity, enclosed bale chamber design. The enclosed chamber design reduces leaf loss and is also cleaner operating than most other round balers. This design has 30 percent fewer parts and eliminates troublesome and expensive belts.

The unit forms a bale with a soft core for faster curing and firm outer layers to retain the round shape. The core density of the bale may be varied by manual ad-

When the bale is completed, twin indicator lights signal the operator to stop, open the cavity and release the finished bale. A light mounted on the tractor also signals the

completion of a bale. M & W also offers a patented plastic wrap attachment to wrap each bale in plastic before the bale is ejected from the bale chamber. This provides protection from the elements when the bales are stored outside and retains the food value of the bale. Once the plastic wrap is installed, the operator can convert from twine to plastic or plastic to twine in minutes.

The baler is available in two models to produce 5'-by-4'-wide or 6'-by-5'-wide bales.

Mueller, 32, holds a B.S. degree in resource economics from the University of New Hampshire and a M.S. degree in resource conservation from the University of Montana.






