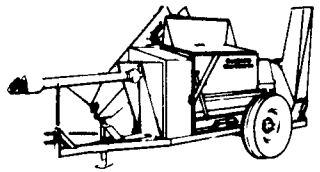

Portable Ear Corn Mill



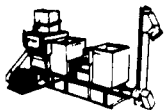

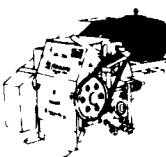
