

# Classy consignments offered at Central Pa. Spring Classic Sale

REEDSVILLE — Spring-Lane Mars Misty emerged as the high selling animal at last week's 35th Central Pennsylvania Spring Classic Sale.

Consigned by Tom Kelly, Tyrone, the Marshfield Elevation Tony daughter brought a bid of \$4000 from Blair and Elaine Courter, Mill Hall.

Misty was scored 88 as a four-year-old and has a three-year-old production record of 18,749 pounds of milk and 699 pounds of fat.

Misty's dam is the 88 point Granville Sovereign Misty. She produced 17,928 pounds of milk and 685 of fat as a five-year-old.

Sale chairmen Don Adams and Roy E. Hall commented on the quality of the 48 animals sold in the Central Pennsylvania Spring Classic. The sale average stood at \$1230.

Dale Baker of Reedsville bought the second high animal for \$2050. William Bradford consigned Bradstead Sexation Alan Star, a three-year-old daughter of Ocean-View Sexation.

Star's dam, Bradstead Alan Rumler Etta, had a top record as a four-year-old of 25,606 pounds of milk and 901 of fat.

A \$2000 bid bought the third high selling animal for Raymond Morningstar of Entriken. Stave Mill Telmatt Peach, a three-year-

old Ronbeth Telmatt daughter, was consigned by Tussey View Farms, Centre Hall.

Peach's dam, Kyperidge Elevation Beauty, gave 27,370 pounds milk and 980 of fat as a four-year-old.

Dean and Robert Loy, Loysville, took home the fourth high animal for \$1800. Long-Ray Vigo Tidy, a six-year-old with a top milk record of more than 20,000 pounds, was consigned by Roy and Glen Henry, Port Royal.

Two cows, each bringing \$1600 and both from Blair County were the fifth high selling animals.

First in the ring was As-Way Chairman Jane, consigned by Fidelity Holsteins of Martinsburg.

Carl Peachy, of Belleville, bought this two-year-old.

The second, Burket Falls Glendell Darlene, was consigned by Burket Falls Farm, East Freedom, and was bought Fred Fouse of James Creek. The six-year-old has a top milk production record of 19,790 pounds milk and 707 pounds fat.

Also sold was a Sunny-Craft Chief Spirit daughter consigned

by Benjamin E. Dum, Ellitsburg. Proceeds from the sale went to the Perry County Junior Holstein Club.

Due May 8 to Duke Jade Starlite of R-K-O, Ben-Lou Spirit Wilma sold to Dan Albright for \$1000. Wilma's dam is Ben-Lou Matt Jr. Whopper, scored 87 and holding a 23,859 pound milk and 902 pound fat record as a two-year-old.
