A Public Auction of real estate and fine antiques was held May 11 for Fannie L. Lehman, Colebrook Road, Elizabethtown, Lancaster Co., Pa. There were approximately 2000 people at the auction.

The 139 acre farm along Colebrook Rd., in Conewago Twp., Dauphin Co. was sold for \$218,810 to Daniel Z. Stoltzfus, R.D. 1, Bird-in-Hand, Pa. It included 2 houses, no barn and 85 acres of tillable land with remaining acreage in wood and pasture land.
