

Shooting Sports Workshop planned

NEWARK, Del. - A Shooting Sports Workshop is planned for June 14, 15 and 16 at Camp Barnes and will feature archery, air rifle, air pistol and shotgun. The workshop is designed for volunteers who are interested in working with youth ages 9-19 in a 4-H Shooting Sports program area back in their town or community.

This workshop offers hands on learning experiences and in-depth training programs featuring sessions in archery, air rifle, air pistol and shotgun and safety measures with youth, program planning, coaching philosophy and

working with youth, wildlife conservation, and working as a team. Participants will review successful models of programs in New York and Texas, and share ideas with others on developing programs and working with volunteers and community resources.

The objectives of the 4-H Shooting Sports program include developing responsible sportsmanship, ethical behavior and respect for safe conduct of shooting sports activities. Participants will gain awareness and appreciation of the broad spec-

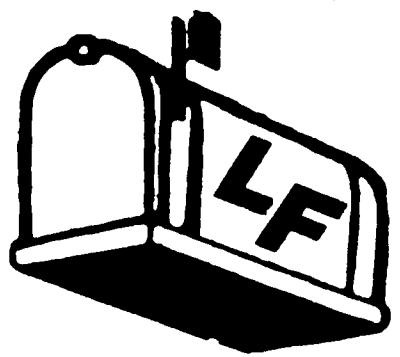
