## Omaha Weekly Thursday, June 20

Report supplied by USDA

Slaughter Steers and Heifers mostly 1.00 lower, some 1.50 lower than last week at the Omaha terminal. A lower beef price complex and poor movement of product from the coolers the dominant factor for the declines at the live level. Buyers still discounting those steers over 1300 lbs. and Heifers over 1200 lbs. Slaughter cows 50 to mostly 1.00 higher. Slaughter Bulls steady.

Estimated 5 day receipts of cattle this week 10,300 compared to actuals of 10,364 last week and 10,945 last year. Slaughter Steers made up 54 pct of the week's supply, Slaughter Heifers 37 pct., Slaughter Cows 6 pct. and feeder cattle 1 pct.

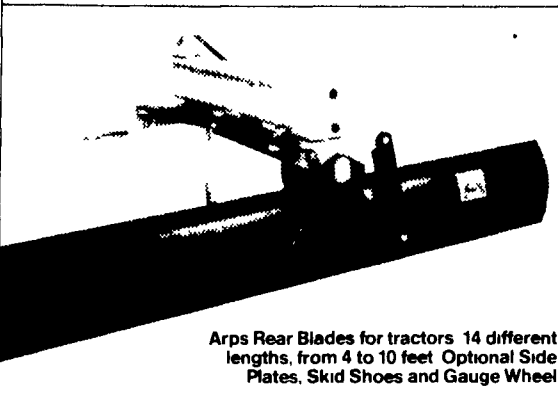

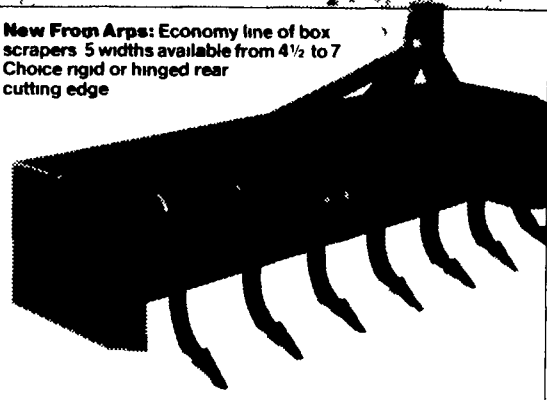

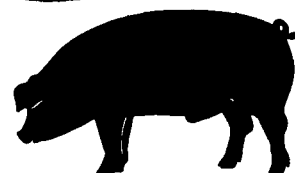
