The advance was credited more, to a "catching-up" process with the late previous week's country trade, than to any optimistic developments this week. Buyer demand ranged from fair to good for most classes, although the usual pressure and discounts applied on overweight and/or overfinished cattle. Supplies of these kinds ran somewhat larger than last week. Cows 1.00-2.00 higher. Bulls 1.00 higher.


