Trading moderate on light to moderate supply. Compared with last week slaughter steers closed weak to .50 lower with heifers firm to mostly .50 higher. Cows steady in limited supply. Bulls generally steady. Supply mainly good to average choice slaughter steers and heifers with 4% cows. Receipts this week about 1900 as compared with 1769 a week ago and 1804 a year ago.
