

Grain stocks up 73%

HARRISBURG — Pennsylvania's corn, oats, wheat and barley stocks on June 1 totaled 63.7 million bushels, up 73 percent from 1984, according to the Pennsylvania Crop and Livestock Reporting Service.

Stocks on farms, at 56.5 million bushels, were up 83 percent from a year earlier. Off-farm stocks, at 7.2 million bushels, were up 21 percent.

Corn stored in all positions totaled 55.1 million bushels, nearly double last year's 29.6 million bushels. Oats held in all positions

amounted to 6.1 million bushels, up 31 percent from 1984's 4.6 million bushels. Wheat stocks in all positions totaled 2.1 million bushels, up two percent from last year's level of 2.0 bushels.

The 546,000 bushels of barley in all storage positions were down eight percent from a year earlier. On farm soybeans stocks totaled 1.2 million bushels, more than double last year's total of 557,000 bushels.

National corn stocks in all positions on June 1 totaled 2.83 billion bushels, 32 percent more

than last year's level of 4.15 billion bushels. Oats in all positions totaled 180 million bushels, down one percent from the previous year.

Barley stored in all positions totaled 248 million bushels, 31 percent more than 1984's 189 million bushels.

Wheat stocks in all positions totaled 1.42 billion bushels, two percent more than the 1.40 billion bushels last year. Soybeans stocks in all positions, at 609 million bushels, were up 29 percent from a year ago. Sorghum stocks in all positions totaled 360 million bushels, two percent less than in 1984.

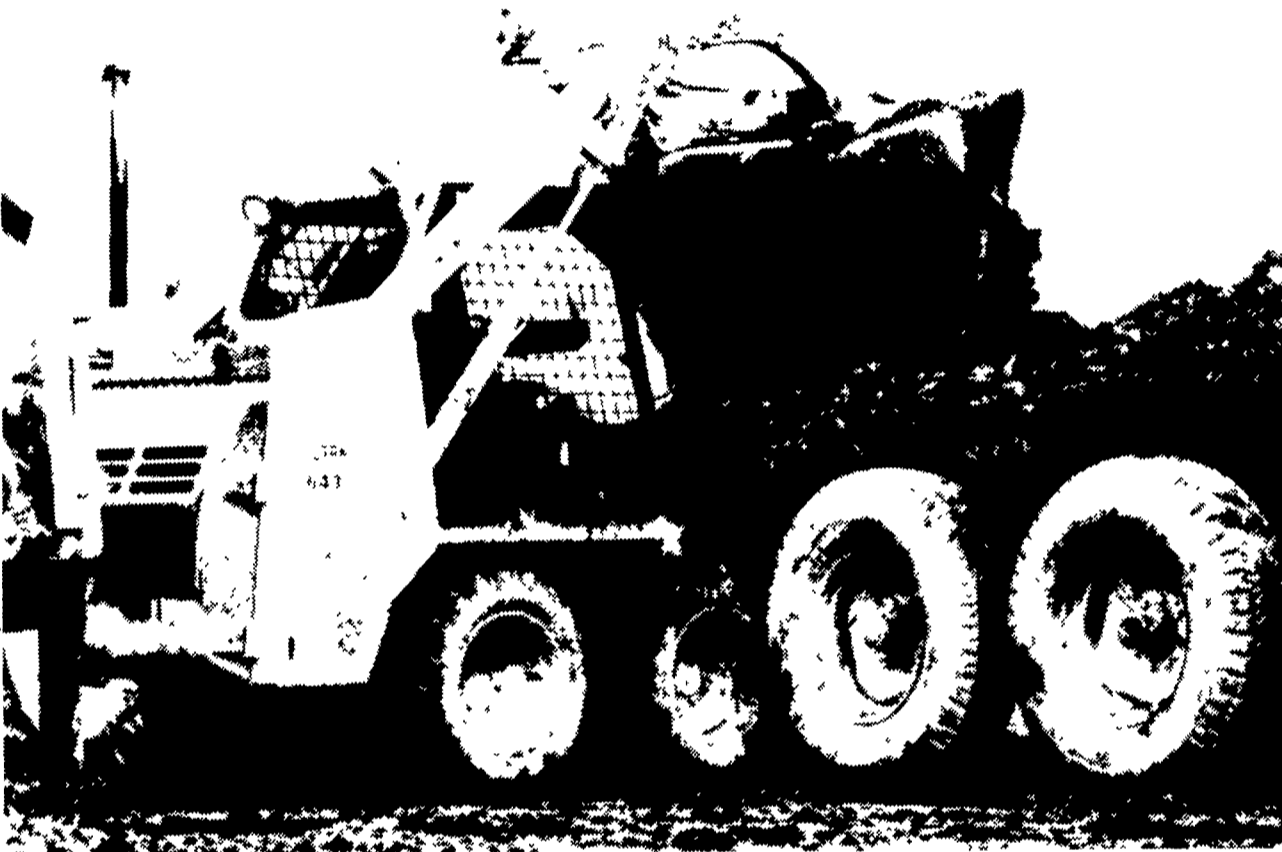
Among the topics discussed, the
