Market Comment: Movement of ready to cook whole birds was moderate overall, and all plants reported few problems in maintaining satisfactory clearances. Inquiry for parts continued to taper but activity was sufficient to clear most product. Live supplies were adequate to tight in instances. Weights were mixed but generally desirable. Slaughter schedules were moderately heavy. Undertone was unsettled with market direction generally noted as dictated by heavy offerings from outside production areas.

Today's L.T.L. asking prices were .02-.03 lower on U.S. Grade A at 47-55 cents.

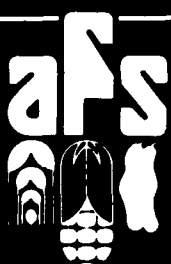
