Market Comment: Demands for ready to cook whole birds continued fairly good overall, and plants again reported little difficulty in clearing current production. Inquiry for parts was light to fair, but the better interest for next week's arrivals.

Live supplies were adequate to barely adequate. Weights continued light to heavy. Slaughter schedules were moderate. Undertone fully steady.

Spotty retail promotional activity and demand from areas catering to the resort trade is stimulating additional call or product but volumes ordered are insufficient to keep supplies of large and extra large from building in many quarters. Floor stocks of large and heavier weights are adequate or available. Mediums are unevenly distributed but adequate overall.

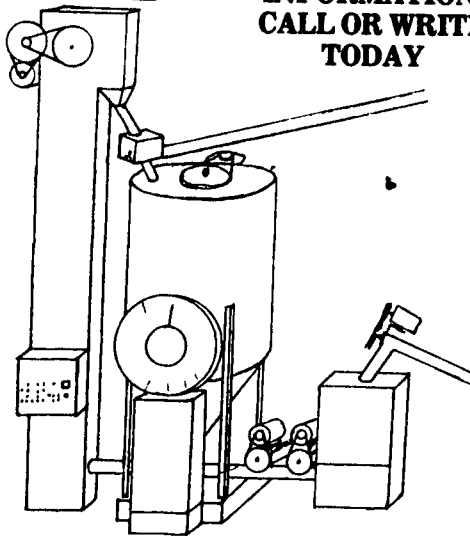
