WEEKLY CATTLE SUMMARY: Feeder steers and heifers 2.00-3.00 lower than last week. Demand moderate for calves including heavy weights from last fall's crop. Demand light for yearlings, bulk of these headed for feedlots. Increased offering calves, however bulk supply continues to be heavy feeders suitable for feeding, includes several 600-900# steers and 550-775# heifers. Slaughter cows 50 cents to 1.00 lower, closing session loss more than offsetting earlier week strength. Slaughter bulls 1.00-2.00 lower, very weak undertone late.

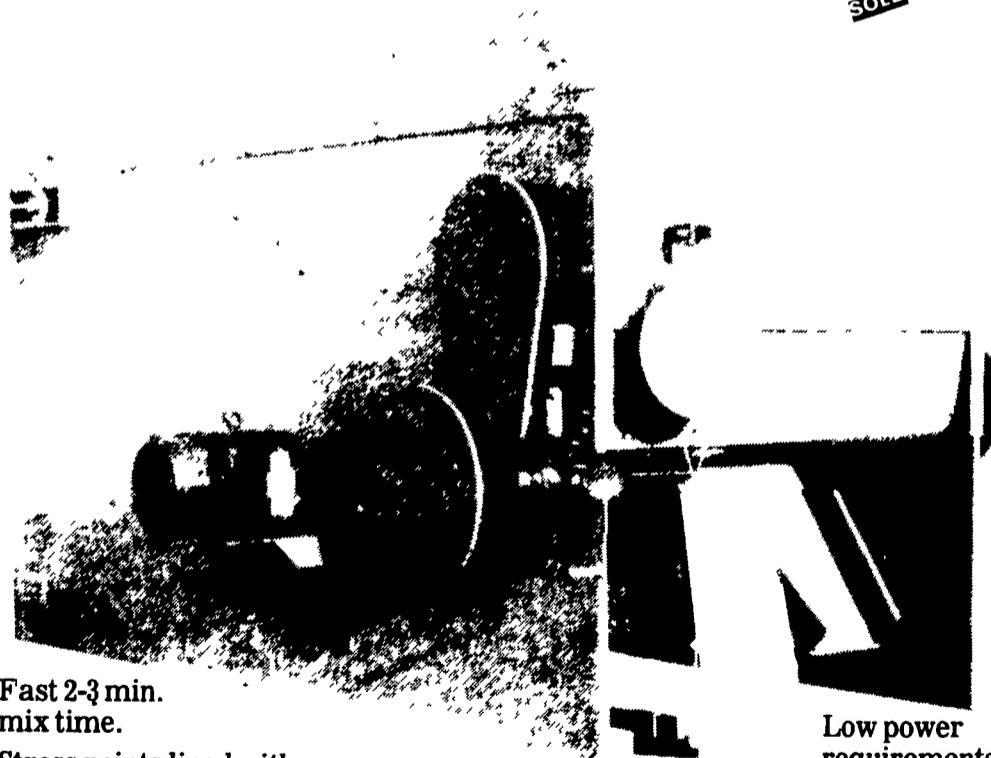
