USDA wants to amend

## fresh tomato standards

WASHINGTON — The U.S. Department of Agriculture proposes to amend the voluntary U.S. standards for grade of fresh tomatoes to bring them in line with current sizing practices.

John J. Gardner, a marketing official with USDA's Agricultural Marketing Service, said the action has been proposed at the request of the Florida Tomato Exchange and the California Fresh Market Tomato Advisory Board.

"The requested change in the diameter requirements of the current generic size designations would reduce the industry's present difficulty in meeting these

size requirements and would promote more uniform trading practices," Gardner said. AMS establishes grade stan-


AMS establishes grade standards and provides official grading for many agricultural products. Use of the standards and the grading service is voluntary and is paid for by the user.

The proposed revised standards are scheduled to be published in the July 24 Federal Register. Suggested changes in the revisions may be sent to the Fruit & Vegetable Division Clerk, Room 2069-S, Agricultural Marketing Service, U.S. Department of Agriculture, Washington, D.C.

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
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
