The 1985 contest featured a change in format, with champions named in each of three hay categories. In previous years only a single grand champion had been named. In the hay crop silage event, however, both a grand and reserve champion were recognized.

Section 3, (partially field cured plus preservatives) Champion: Doug and Paul Vonanda, Howard (Centre Co.). Sample: alfalfa/grass mix, later cut.

Sample: Mainly grass, wilted, 60% moisture.

Reserve Champion. Herman Espy, Spruce Creek.
