

Woodland, wildlife workshop slated in Dauphin Co.

HARRISBURG It's the opening day of small game season, you and your daughter are walking the same fields you hunted as a boy. The morning started with memories and stories of hunts past when you flushed a dozen ringnecks and twice that many cottontails.

By early afternoon you flushed three hens and a lone sprinter ringneck that avoided you by

running into the next county. Later your daughter looks at you and asks, "Dad, are you sure in the old days you found flocks of pheasants?"

You just received an offer on your front porch from an eager firewood cutter interested in obtaining permission to cut firewood on your 20-acre woodlot. Before you answer, you find a dozen

questions in your mind. What's a fair price to sell my trees as fuelwood? Can I get more by selling them for sawtimber? What trees should be cut? What am I liable for if he had an accident cutting wood on my land? Who can answer all these questions?

These questions and scenarios will be addressed during the day-long Woodlot and Wildlife Management Workshop on Sept

28, sponsored by the Dauphin Co. Conservation District.

If you are a woodlot owner, farmer, hunter, birdwatcher, or any combination of these four groups, wildlife management and forestry are most likely two topics of interest to you. The consulting firm of Wildlife Managers will conduct two classroom sessions in the morning at Camp Hebron. In the afternoon use your newly found

knowledge to look for examples of multiple use during a Tree Farm tour.

"In his new capacity, Dr. Davidson will be responsible for the direct maintenance of the technical and administrative

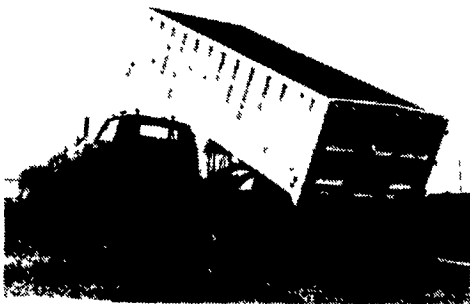
