NFU warns of 'collapse' of U.S. farm economy

CORNING, IA — "Imports are killing the American pork producers," DeVon Woodland, president of the National Farmers Organization, claimed in telegrams to the U.S. Department of Agriculture and the U.S. International Trade Commission.

Woodland said the producers' position was "totally eroded" this week with the Iowa and Nebraska interior markets dropping to \$38-39 per hundredweight.

"This level of market is creating a \$10-15 per head loss for the pork producer. He just cannot live with the approximate 7 percent imports of the federally inspected domestic slaughter," Woodland said.

The telegrams were addressed to John Block, the agriculture

secretary, and to Paula Stern, ITC chairperson.

Woodland said "this callous disregard for the future of American agriculture must stop and our domestic producers must be protected from outside influences such as pork imports."

With no further controls implemented, Woodland noted he "foresees domestic pork prices plunging into the \$35/cwt. range or lower, causing financial liquidation of existing pork facilities nationwide."

"The American hog producer can return to profitable levels only when he doesn't have to battle various agencies of the administration," Woodland concluded.
