Cartoned egg orders were irregular, ranging just fair to instances good, mainly due to retail ad activity and increased needs for the first of the month buying period. Graded supplies of large and extra large were adequate to heavy. Mediums were generally adequate to fully adequate. Additional offerings were available in both graded and ungraded packs. Buying interest was spotty and somewhat cautious.


