The top herd of registered Holsteins completed the month with a rolling herd average of 18 005 pounds of milk per cow

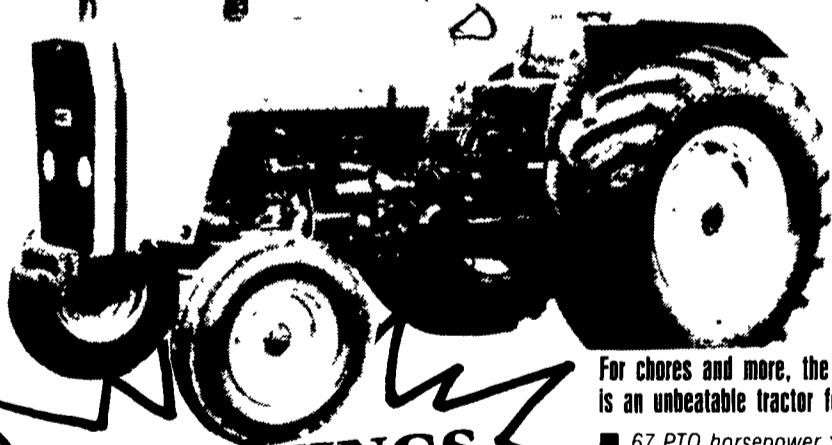
