Day-to-day buyer demand ran at a brisk pace as wholesale beef prices rebounded from last week's lows, gaining 3.00-5.00 dollars cwt in the process. Overall finish continued fairly attractive, while the ongoing discounts still applied on a modest supply of 'over-fat' and/or 'overweight' kinds. Cows .50 lower. Bulls steady.

Estimated 5 day receipts 7600, actuals' last week 9001 and last year 7595. Steers comprised 35 percent of the week's receipts; heifers 33 percent; cows 5 percent; feeders 26 percent.


