U.S. No. 2 175 lb. Pork carcass cutout value declined .35 to \$61.64 per cwt.

Compared to Tuesday's 4:00 P.M. report, choice 3 steer carcasses not fully established an ample supplies, choice heifers \$1.00-2.00 higher good grade and holstein type steady. Demand and trading light with packers holding firm on moderate to heavy supplies. The gross boxed beef carcass cutout value declined \$.24 to an estimated \$104.56 per cwt., 319 loads boxed cuts reported.
